

End-point Assessment sequence

Hair Professionals (Barbering)

Recommended running order

Apprentices should agree any changes to their End-point Assessment sequence with the VTCT Apprenticeship Assessor prior to the commencement of the End-point Assessment. The second page contains a blank template for the apprentice to use if they wish.

Cut facial hair into shape (full)	20 mins

* The apprentice will be asked a set of oral questions by the VTCT Apprenticeship Assessor at specific intervals, usually at the end of each element observation, during the End-point Assessment. Timings for the oral questions are not included in the overall total time allocated for the End-point Assessment.
