## Level 2 & Level 3 Hairdressing and Level 2 Barbering

### Entry requirements



There are no formal entry requirements for the Level 2 qualifications. However, for Level 3 hairdressing, it is recommended that learners should hold a Level 2 hairdressing qualification.

### Overall graded outcome

These qualifications are for learners aged 16+. The qualifications reward the learners' individual abilities both in practical methods and theory with an overall graded outcome.



### Meets local needs

For hairdressing, there are choices for optional units to tailor the training to support local client needs, as well as tutor and learner resources to support training.



### Assessment methods

These qualifications include theory examinations (multiple choice questions) for specific units, a synoptic practical examination (end examination) and a service portfolio with style collections of the learners' work.
